Tomorrow's Leaders for Sustainability (TLfS) is a new initiative that helps young people understand and appreciate the key principles and issues of sustainability, while also gaining the knowledge and skills to become leaders in their future careers. The objective is to help young people understand the world around them, as well as to help them develop the ability to think for themselves, communicate their thoughts and feelings, act on their own beliefs and encourage others to act in an ethical and socially responsible way.

Tomorrow's Leaders for Sustainability courses have been developed for both secondary and primary schools and are aligned to VELs and the E5 Instructional Model. The TLfS team is now using Guide Beside approaches to train teachers and educators in sustainability to conduct the program in schools.

BGK LLEN and the TLfS team are keen to work with primary teachers in schools in the Bayside region to deliver the program in 2010. Due to a financial support from the BGK LLEN and the City of Bayside there will be **no charge** for schools in the region. (This represents a saving of \$550 per school)

This workshop will give you the background, pedagogy and resources to run the program yourself, with support from the TLfS team. It will introduce you to the three elements of the program: Educational Activities, Project Activities and Leadership Activities. You will experience practical, learning by doing activities and receive a free copy of a detailed student manual and teacher's notes, plus a copy of both *Ollie Saves the Planet* and *Ollie's Island* CD ROMs. Find out about how to become an accredited TLfS facilitator.
